Achillea (Yarrow): Full Sun – Summer Flowering
‘Cerise Queen’: 20-24”, rosy flower heads.

Aegopodium (Snow on the Mountain): Groundcover. Sun – Shade.

Agastache (Hyssop, Mexican Mint): Full Sun – Heat and drought tolerant
‘Sonoran Sunset’: 15”, lavender-rose flowers.

Alcea (Hollyhock): Full Sun. Biennials or short-lived perennials. Reseed.
‘Simplex Mix’: 60", old fashioned mixed colors.
‘Chaters Double Salmon Pink’: 40-60”, double pink blooms.
‘Chaters Double Red’: 40-60”, red blooms.
‘Chaters Double Yellow’: 40-60”, double yellow blooms.
‘Charters Double Violet’: 6', double, dark purple blooms.
‘Malva Zebrina’: 30”, single white and purple blooms most of summer.
‘Nigra’: 48-72”, single dark maroon flowers.

Alyssum (Gold Dust – Perennial Madwort): Groundcover. Full Sun.

Anchusa (Alkanet, Bugloss): Full/Part Sun – well drained soil.
‘Blue Angel’: 12”, ultramarine blue flowers in early summer.

Anemone (Wind Flower): Sun/Part Shade, well drained soil.
‘Sylvestris’: 15”, white flowers in spring.
‘Annabelle Deep Rose’: 15”, rose flowers in spring.

Anemone pulsatilla (Pasqueflower): Part Sun/Spring bloom – 15”, mauve flowers.

Anthemis hyb. 'Kelwayi' (Golden Marguerite Daisy): Full Sun - June-Sept. bloom –
18-24”, gray foliage and bright yellow flowers.

Aquilegia (Columbine): Part Sun – Part Shade. Spring blooms. Attracts hummingbirds.

‘Alpine Blue’: 8”, true blue blooms.
‘Crimson Star’: 18-30”, white with long red spurs.
‘Canadensis’: 12-24”, red flowers.
‘Songbird Bunting’: 18”, blue blooms.
‘Songbird Cardinal’: 24-30”, red and pink blooms.
‘Songbird Goldfinch’: 24-30”, golden yellow blooms.
‘Songbird Robin’: 24-30”, pink and white blooms.
‘Spring Magic Blue & White’: 14”, blue & white blooms with long spurs.
‘Spring Magic Rose & Ivory’: 14”, rose & ivory blooms with long spurs.

‘Swan Violet and White’: 24”, white with long purple spurs.
‘Winky Double Red and White’: 12-20”, double flowers of red and white.
‘Winky Double Blue and White’: 12-20”, double flowers of blue and white

Arenaria ‘Avalanche’ (Sandwort): Groundcover. 4-5”, Full Sun. Early summer bloom.

Arisaema triphyllum (Jack-in-the-Pulpit): 18-24”. **Native Woodland**. Orange berries. Purple/bronze flowers in May. Grow in rich, moist soil in full shade to part sun.

Armeria (Thrift, Sea Pinks): Groundcover. Full Sun. Salt tolerant.

‘Maritima Splendens’: 6”, pink flowers.
‘Joystick Red’: 15”, globular red blooms on tall stems.

Artemisia (White Sage, Wormwood): Full/Part Sun. Aromatic foliage. Inconspicuous flowers.

‘Powis castle’: 36”, heavily serrated silver foliage with mounding habit.
‘Silver Brocade’: 10”, silver-white, serrated foliage.
‘Silver Mound’: Groundcover. 10”, silvery-gray foliage. Long-lived.

Aruncus (Goatsbeard): Part Shade – Shade.

‘dioicus’: 36-48”, white blooms in early summer.

Asarum canadense (Wild Ginger): Sun to Part Sun. Groundcover. Native. 6-8”.

Asclepias (Butterfly Weed): Full Sun. Blooms June – August. Native.

‘tuberosa’: 15”, orange blooms.
‘Hello Yello’: 15”, yellow blooms.

Aster: Full Sun – Blooms in late summer-fall.

‘Alma Potschke’: 48”, bright rose-pink flowers.
‘Alpine Dwarf Mix’: 12”, purple, blue or pinkish flowers/yellow centers.
‘Professor Kippenberg’: 12-15”, lavender-blue semi-double blooms.
‘Purple Dome’: 12-18”, deep purple.
‘Red Alert’: 12-15”, crimson
‘Wood’s Purple’: 12-16”, purple.

Bellis (English Daisy): Groundcover. Sun/Part Sun. Well-drained soil.

‘Tasso Strawberry’s & Cream’: 8”, pink centers with creamy-pink petals.
‘Galaxy Red’: 6-8”, double red pompon red blooms with yellow eye.

Boltonia (Boltonia Aster): Full Sun. Well-drained soil. Late summer bloom.

‘Nana’: 18-24”, pinkish-lilac flowers.

Caltha palustris (Marsh Marigold): 6-10", Native Woodland. Bright yellow flowers in March-May. Rich, moist to wet soil in full shade to part shade.

Campanula (Bellflower): Sun/Part Sun.

- 'Champion Blue': 24-30", blue cup and saucer. Heavy bloomer.
- 'Champion Pink': 24-30", pink cup and saucer. Heavy bloomer.
- 'Light Blue Clips': Groundcover. 10", light blue flowers summer to fall.
- 'White Clips': Groundcover. 10", white flowers in late spring.
- 'Blue Clips': 10", Blue/purple flowers.

Catanache (Cupid's Dart): Sun and light, well-drained soil. 18", clumps of grassy gray-green leaves and blue, daisy-like flowers.

Centaurea (Cornflower/Bachelor Button): Full Sun. Well-drained soil.

- 'Dealbata Rose': 18-30", soft rose-pink flowers in early summer.
- 'Macrocephala': 36", large bright yellow flowers in summer.
- 'Montana': 18-24", blue flowers in spring.

Centranthus (Valerian/Jupiter's Beard): Full Sun, drought tolerant. Blooms from spring to fall.

- 'Ruber Red': 12-24", crimson flowers.

Cerastium (Snow in Summer): Groundcover. Full Sun. Late spring bloom.

- 'Tomentosum': 4-6", bright white blooms, silvery leaves.

Ceratostigma (Plumbago, Leadwort): Groundcover. 6-12", Full to part-sun. Blue flower clusters in summer. Foliage turns mahogany in fall.

Chelone (Turtle Head): Sun to Moderate Shade, Moist Soil. Long Blooming

- 'Obliqua Pink': 36", rose-purple tubular flowers.
- 'Obliqua White': 36", bright white tubular flowers.

Coreopsis (Tickseed): Full Sun. Attracts butterflies. Summer bloom.

- 'Baby Sun': 16", yellow.
- 'Early Sunrise': 18", double yellow flowers.
- *'Route 66': 24": burgundy-red and yellow.
- *'Sienna Sunset': 20", Terra cotta-orange flowers.
- 'Verticillata Rose': Groundcover. 20-24", medium-pink flowers.
- 'Verticillata Zagreb': Groundcover. 12", golden star-shaped flowers.

Delosperma cooperi (Purple Ice Plant): Creeping gray-green foliage. Magenta flowers in May- July. Grow in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Rock garden, groundcover, containers.

- 'John Proffitt' aka 'Table Mountain': 2-4", bright pink flowers.
- 'Red Mountain': 2-3", Pinkish-red with cream centers.

Delphinium (Larkspur): Full Sun. Summer bloom.

- ‘Belladonna Bellamosum’: 15”, dark blue.
- ‘Blue Butterfly’: 14”, deep blue flowers.
- ‘Laurin’: 12-15”, bright red – attractive to hummingbirds.
- ‘Summer Blues’: 12”, soft blue flowers throughout summer.
- ‘Summer Morning’: 12”, Light pink throughout summer.
- ‘Summer Nights’: 12”, blue blooms throughout summer.
- ‘Magic Fountain Dark Blue/Dark Bee’: 36”, blue flowers with dark centers.
- ‘Magic Fountain Dark Blue/White Bee’: 36”, blue flowers with white center.
- ‘Magic Fountain Lilac Pink’: 36”, lilac pink flowers.
- ‘Magic Fountain Pure White’: 36”, white flowers.
- ‘Magic Fountain Sky Blue’: 30”, sky blue flowers.
- ‘Pacific Giant Black Knight’: 6’, deep midnight-violet flowers.
- ‘Pacific Giant Blue Bird’: 6’, medium blue with white bee.
- ‘Pacific Giant King Arthur’: 6’, dark royal-violet flowers.
- ‘Pacific Giant Summer Skies’: 6’, clear, light blue flowers with white bee.

Dianthus (Border Carnation): Groundcover. Full Sun. Deadhead.

- ‘Barbatus Bouquet Purple’: 36”, rose-purple flowers.
- ‘Barbatus Indian Carpet Mix’: 10”, wide color range. Summer.
- ‘Barbatus Pinocchio’: 15”, clusters of mixed double flowers.
- ‘Deltoides Brilliant’: 6”, deep-red, flowers June to September.
- ‘Dessert Cranberry Ice’: 7”, dark red eye & fringe, light pink center.
- ‘Dessert Raspberry Swirl’: 7”, dark red eye & fringe, blush center.
- ‘Dessert Strawberry Sorbet’: 7”, red eye & fringe and light red center.
- ‘Eastern Star’: 7”, solid red flowers.
- ‘Firewitch’: 6”, hot pink flowers, fragrant.
- ‘Purple Picotee’: 6-8”, purple with white margins.
- ‘Red Picotee’: 6-8”, red with white margins.
- ‘Tiny Rubies’: 4-5”, rose-pink flowers in May-June.

Dicentra cucullaria (Dutchman’s Breeches): Native Woodland. Dainty springtime flowers. 10”, partial shade.

Digitalis (Foxglove): Part Sun. Self seeding perennial.

- ‘Camelot Rose’: 48”, rose red blooms in spring and summer.
- ‘Carillon Temple Bells’: 20”, yellow tubular flowers.
- ‘Foxy’: 36”, range of colors, June & July.
- ‘Mertonensis’: (Strawberry Foxglove): 36-48”, pink flowers.

Dodecatheon meudia (Shooting Star): Native Woodland. 8-24”, yellow-centered white flowers in May. Full Sun to Part Shade.

Echinacea (Coneflower): Full Sun. Summer flowering.

- ‘Doubledecker’: Semi double to double pink blooms.

- ‘Magnus’: 36”, red with maroon centers.
- ‘Primadonna White’: 36”, 4-5” pure white flowers.
- ‘Ruby Star’: 36-48”, carmine-red flowers.
- ‘White Swan’: 18-20”, pure white, honey-scented flowers.

Erigeron (Fleabane): Full Sun. 15-24”, large violet-tined, blue flowers with yellow centers. June – July.

Erinus Alpinus (Alpine Blue Daisy): Groundcover. 6”, purple flowers in spring. (Mayfield)

Euphorbia (Spurge): Full/Part Sun.

- ‘Donkey Tail’: 6”, Gray-green leaves are produced in spirals/yellow flowers.
- ‘Chameleon’: 18”, yellow flowers over bronze-purple foliage.

Fragaria virginiana (Woodland Strawberry): **Native Woodland**. Small, edible red fruits. Spreads by runners. White flowers in April-June. 4-12”. Part Sun to Part Shade.

Gaillardia (Blanket Flower): Full Sun. Blooms most of the season.

- ‘Arizona Sun’: 10”, Mahogany red with yellow tips.
- ‘Burgundy’: 14-28”, wine-red blooms – deadhead.
- ‘Goblin’: 9-12”, red edged with yellow.
- ‘Golden Goblin’: 15”, golden blooms – deadhead.

Geranium (Cranesbill): Groundcover. Full Sun/Part Shade.

- ‘Biokovo’: 12-18”, clear blue with pale center from June-Sept.
- ‘Johnson's Blue’: 18”, large brilliant blue flowers.
- ‘Sanguineum Vision Violet’: 12-15”, violet flowers.
- ‘Wargrave Pink’: 24”, salmon-pink flowers.

Geum (Avens): Full/Part Sun.

- ‘Cooky’: 10-12”, single orange-scarlet flowers, spring blooming.
- ‘Double Bloody Mary’: 16”, semi-double fire engine red blooms.

Grasses (Ornamental): Full Sun.

- ‘Carex Red Rooster’: 15-18”, reddish-bronze.
- ‘Festuca Glauca, Elijah Blue’: 10”, nice blue.

Grasses (Native):

- ‘Andropogon, Big Bluestem’: 6-7’, blue-green to silvery blue foliage, red-toned in fall. Purplish flowers in July-August. Full sun to part shade.
- ‘Sorghastrum, Indian Grass’: 36-60”, Bright green foliage. Red in fall. Pale rust flowers in Aug-Sept. Full sun.

‘Schizachyrium, Little Blue Stem’: 36”, bluish-green to light purplish-colored foliage.

Gypsophilia (Baby’s Breath): Full Sun. Mid-summer bloom.

‘Paniculata, Snowflake’: 24-36”, Larger flowers than most.

‘Pacifica’: 36”, tiny double pink blooms.

‘Repens Rose’: 6”, pink flowers May - July.

Hepatica acutiloba (Hepatica): Native Woodland. 4-6”, bluish flowers in May. Full Shade.

Heuchera (Coral Bells): Groundcover. Part Sun.

‘Melting Fire’: Curled reddish-maroon leaves, white blooms.

‘Palace Purple’: 18”, white flowers May-June.

‘Ruby Bells’: 12”, ruby blooms late spring, sweetly scented.

‘Splendens Firefly’: 24”, bright carmine-red flowers in May-July.

Heucherella (Foamy Bells): Part Sun. Flowers in early spring.

‘Bridget Bloom’: 18”, light pink flowers.

Houttuynia cordata (Chameleon Plant): Groundcover. 6-10”, marginal water plant with aromatic, leathery leaves. Small sprays of white flowers. Full Sun/Part Sun.

Hypericum (St. John’s Wort): Full Sun, well-drained soil.

‘Calycinum’: 12”, yellow flowers.

‘Tricolor’: 24-36”, yellow flowers over variegated foliage.

Iberis (Candytuft): Groundcover. Full sun. Evergreen.

‘Alexander’s White’: 8-12”, large dense white blooms in spring.

Kniphofia tritoma (Torch Lily, Poker Plant): Full Sun.

‘Flamenco Mix’: 32”, yellows, oranges and reds.

Lamium (Dead Nettle): Groundcover for Part Sun to Shade.

‘Anne Greenway’: 6”, lavender blooms over tri-color foliage.

‘Beacon Silver’: 6”, silver-white leaves/green margins, lavender flowers.

‘Herman’s Pride’: 12”, silver and green variegated. Yellow spring flowers.

‘Pink Pewter’: 6”, silvery variegated foliage with pink spring blooms.

‘Red Nancy’: 8-12”, variegated leaves and long-blooming red flowers.

‘White Nancy’: 6”, silver-white leaves w/green margins – white blooms.

Lathyrus latifolius mix (Wild Sweet Pea): 4-8’, red and white flowers. Sun/Part Sun.

Leucanthemum Superbum (Shasta Daisy): Full/Part Sun.

‘Alaska’: 20”, classic with pure white flowers and yellow centers.

‘Crazy Daisy’: 36”, pure white, double flowers.

‘Old Court’: 30-36”, white, thin twisted flower petals.
‘Snowcap’: 10-12”, long lasting pure white flowers.

Lewisa (Bitterroot): Part shade. Succulent, rock garden plant.
cotyledon ‘Rainbow mix’: 10-12”, Mix of colors.
longipetala ‘Little Peach’: 6-8”, Peach/orange/Yellow Flowers.
longipetala ‘Little Plum’: 8-10”, Magenta/orange flowers.

Linum (Flax): Full/Part Sun. Everblooming. Short-lived but self-seeding.
‘Sapphire’: 14”, dainty blue blooms.

Lobelia (Cardinal Flower): Full Sun/Part Shade, Good for moist locations. Attracts hummingbirds.

‘Queen Victoria’: 3-4’, light shade, bright red blooms.
‘Great Blue’: Native. 24-36”, blue flowers in July-August.
‘Green Native Grass’: Native. 12-18”, cardinal-red flowers in July-August.

Lupinus (Lupine): Full/Part Sun. Seeds and seedpods are poisonous.
‘Gallery Blue’: 2-3’, early summer, 2-tone blue and white flowers.
‘Gallery Pink’: 2-3’, pink flower spikes in early summer.
‘Gallery Red’: 2-3’, red flower spikes in late spring.
‘Gallery Yellow’: 2-3’, late spring bloom.

Lychnis (Catchfly): Full Sun – self seeds.
‘Chalcedonica’: 24”, bright red flowers in early summer.
*‘Gardener’s World’: 36”, Magenta flowers over silvery foliage.
‘Orange Gnome’: 8”, orange flowers against bronze foliage.

Lysimachia (Loosestrife): Sun/Shade.
‘Green Moneywort’: 2-4”, fast growing – yellow flowers in late spring.
‘Aurea’: 2-4”, yellow flowers with yellow leaves.
‘Firecracker’: 24”, upright plant with yellow flowers and purple foliage.

Mertensia (Virginia Bluebells): Shade. **Native Woodland**. Goes dormant in summer.
Blue bell-like flowers.

Monarda (Bee Balm): Full/Part Sun. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
‘Blue Stocking’: 36”, violet-blue flowers.
‘Cambridge Scarlet’: 36-48”, scarlet flowers.
‘Grand Marshall’: 22”, Fuchsia-purple flowers.
‘Raspberry Wine’: 36-40”, raspberry wine-red blooms. (4” & G)
‘White’: 36”, white blooms on mint-scented foliage.

Myosotis (Forget-Me-Not): Full/Part Sun. Spring-early summer blooms. Short lived.
‘Bluesylva’: blue flowers.
‘Rosylva’: pink flowers.

‘Snowsylvia’: White flowers.

Oenothera (Evening Primrose): Full Sun/Part Shade. Paper-thin flowers all summer.

‘Missouri Primrose’: 10”, yellow flowers in spring – open in evening.

‘Siskiyou’: 10”, bright pink, slightly fragrant blooms in spring.

‘Sunset Boulevard’: 24”, tangerine blooms fading to crimson.

‘Tetragona Sundrops’: 15”, bright yellow flowers in early summer.

Papaver (Poppy): Full Sun.

‘Alpine Mix’: 10”, white, pink or yellow flowers in late spring.

*‘**Champagne Bubbles Orange**’: 12-15”, orange blooms.

‘Iceland Wonderland Mix’: 10”, red/orange/yellow/pink and white flowers.

‘Oriental Crimson Red’: 24-30”, crimson red blooms.

‘Oriental Orange Scarlet’: 36”, orange flowers.

Penstemon (Beard-tongue): Full/Part Sun. Attracts hummingbirds. Summer.

‘Husker Red’: 30-36”, white flowers with a pink blush and deep red foliage.

‘Rondo Mix’: 16”, wide range of colors.

Perovskia (Russian Sage): Full Sun.

‘Atriplicifolia’: 4-5’, lavender blue airy flower spikes in summer and fall.

‘Little Spire’: 2-3’, same flowers on shorter plant.

Phlox (Woodland): moist location with well-drained soil in Sun/Partial Shade.

‘Divartica’: 12”, lavender-blue flowers in May-June.

Phlox subulata (Creeping Phlox): Groundcover. Evergreen with stiff, needle-like foliage. Forms a dense mat. Small flowers are extremely showy in spring and early summer. Full Sun.

s. ‘Atropururea’: 6”, rich wine-red flowers.

s. ‘Candy Stripes’: 6”, White and pink two-toned flowers.

s. ‘Emerald Blue’: 6”, lavender-blue flowers.

s. ‘Emerald Pink’: 6”, clear pink flowers.

s. ‘White Delight’: 6”, pure white flowers.

Phlox (Garden): Full/Part Sun. summer blooms.

‘Bright Eyes’: 36”, pale pink flowers with hot pink eyes.

‘Laura’: 48”, purple blooms with white eyes.

*‘**Minnie Pearl**’: 12-18”, White Blooms, mildew resistant.

‘Miss Candy’: 48”, deep pink blooms.

‘Salmon’: 48”, Salmon and white flowers.

Physalis franchetti (Chinese Lantern): Sun/Part Shade. Orange/scarlet seed pods late summer. 18-24".

Physostegia (Obedient Plant): Full/Part Sun. May become invasive.
‘Pink’: 24”, pink flowers in summer.
‘Crown of Snow’: 24-36”, pure white flowers in July-August.

Platycodon (Balloon Flower): Full Sun. Foliage emerges in late spring but flowers most of summer. Intolerable of wet soil.
‘Sentimental Blue’: 8-10”, large, vivid blue flowers.

Polemonium caeruleum (Jacob’s Ladder): Part Shade.
‘Apricot Delight’: 20”, apricot flowers.
‘Blue Pearl’: 18”, blue flowers.

Polygonatum biflorum (Solomon’s Seal): Shade. **Native Woodland.** Prefers a moist organic soil in a woodland setting.

Potentilla (Cinquefoil): Groundcover – Full Sun/Part Sun.
‘Miss Wilmott’: 12”, pink flowers w/cherry-red centers.
‘Tonguei’: 24”, showy apricot flowers with a crimson center.

Primula (Primrose): Full/Part Sun. Fragrant, spring-flowering.
‘Pacific Giant Mix’: 10”, large flowers in a wide range of colors.

Pyrethrum (Painted Daisy): Full/Part Sun. Attracts butterflies.
‘Robinson’s Mix’: 20”, shades of pink, rose and red blooms in summer.
‘Robinson’s Red’: 20”, red blooms.

Ranunculus (Creeping Buttercup): Groundcover, Shade to Sun. Moist soils. Naturalizes and may become invasive.
‘Buttered Popcorn’: 10-12”, yellow blooms over yellow-green foliage.

Ratibida (Mexican Hat): Full Sun – Summer blooms.
‘Columnaris Red Pulche’: 1-3’, bright red flowers.
‘Yellow Coneflower’: Native. 36-48”, bright clear yellow flowers.

Rudbeckia (Black-eyed Susan): Full/Part Sun, long-lasting blooms.
*‘Cherry Brandy’: 20-24”, Cherry-red flowers.
*‘Denver Daisy’: 18-28”, Gold flowers with chocolate centers.
‘Goldstrum’: 2-2 ½’, golden yellow.
‘Hirta’: Native, 48”, golden-orange blooms.
‘Indian Summer’: Biennial. 36-42”, yellow blooms with a brown center.
‘Irish Eyes’: 30”, yellow daisy flowers with green eyes.
‘Rustic Colors’: 24”, mix of yellow, bronze and mahogany blooms.
‘Triloba’: 24-36”, Brown-eyed Susan, part shade tolerant.

Sagina (Irish Moss): Groundcover. Sun/Shade.

‘Aurea’: 3”, gold foliage. (Scotch Moss)

‘Subulta’: 2”, small white flowers.

Salvia (Meadow Sage): Full Sun – early summer bloom.

‘Argentea’: 24”, large, white-wooly foliage, white flowers in June-July.

‘Blue Hills’: Groundcover. 18-24”, true blue.

‘Caradonna’: 24”, purple flowers with dark stems.

‘East Freisland’: Groundcover. 18”, violet blue, long summer bloom time.

‘May Night’: Groundcover. 12-18”, violet blue, long summer bloom time.

‘Purple Rain’: 18”, purple flowers over large foliage.

‘Snow Hill’: Groundcover. 20”, pure white.

Saponaria (Soapwort): Groundcover. Full Sun. Vigorous.

Saxifraga (Rockfoil): Full Sun. Spring blooming.

‘Purple Robe’: 6-8”. Bright green foliage, deep carmine-red/pink flowers.

Scabiosa (Pincushion flower): Full Sun, well-drained soil. All summer blooming.

‘Butterfly Blue’: 12-15”, lavender flowers over fuzzy foliage.

Sedum (Stonecrop): Groundcover. Full Sun.

‘Autumn Joy’: 18-24”, red flowers in fall.

‘Blue Spruce’: 3-4”, silvery-blue, spruce-like foliage, bright yellow flowers.

‘Bronze Carpet’: 4-6”, bronze colored foliage.

‘Dragon’s Blood’: 4”, bronze-green leaves, rose-red flowers.

‘Ewersii’: 8”, creeping bluish-green foliage. Rosy-pink flowers.

‘Makinoi Ogon’: 2”, Golden leaves, gold flowers.

‘Matrona’: 18-24”, rosy flowers over dark tinted foliage.

‘Kamtschaticum Variegatum’: 8”, variegated leaves/Orange-yellow flowers.

‘Rosy Glow’: 8”, large, pink flowers cover blue-green foliage.

‘Sieboldii’: 6-10”, bluish-green and pink flowers.

‘Vera Jameson’: 9-12”, deep purple foliage, pink flowers.

‘Voodoo’: 3-4”, pink flowers over dark purple foliage.

‘Weihenstephaner’: 6”, masses of yellow flowers.

‘Purple Emperor’: 16”, dark foliage and reddish-pink flowers.

Sempervivum (Hens and Chicks): Full Sun

*‘Red Heart’: 2-4”, grey petals with central red heart.

*‘Red Rubin’: 2-4”, red petals tipped with green.

Stachys (Lamb’s Ear): Full Sun. Groundcover.

‘Lantana’: 12-15”, velvety soft, grayish-white leaves.

Statice Limonium latifolia (Sea Lavender): 24-30”, Full Sun. Blue-purple flowers in summer.

Statice Goniolimon tataricum (German Statice): 12-18", Full Sun. White flowers in summer.

Thymus serpyllum (Creeping Thyme): Full Sun, Ground cover.

‘Coccineum’: 4", reddish-pink flowers.

‘Minus’: 1", light pink flowers.

Trillium (Trillium): Shade. **Native Woodland.** Grow in rich, moist soil in a woodland setting.

‘grandiflorum’: 12", large white flowers.

‘luteum’: 12", large soft yellow flowers.

Tunica (Petrorhagia) saxifraga (Tunic Flower): Groundcover. Low growing, grassy foliage with pinkish or purplish-white flowers July – September. Full Sun/Part Sun. 10-12".

Verbena (Perennial): Groundcover. Full Sun. Late spring bloom.

‘Toronto’: 8-14", bright lavender flowers.

Veronica (Speedwell): Groundcover. Full/Part Sun.

‘Blue Charm’: 18-24", lavender blue blooms all summer.

‘Georgia Blue’: 4-6", bright blue blooms in May-June.

‘Red Fox’: 15-18", free flowering red blooms in summer.

‘Royal Candles’: 15-18", conical violet-blue blooms, clean foliage.

‘Sunnyborder Blue’: 12-18", dark blue flowers from June to frost.
